2. MCSA Misconduct

Discussion:

- Amy gave rundown of MCSA history: issues since 2024. Gave basic timeline as per provided document. Provided her opinion that MCSA doesn't respect MONSU Caulfield and that the club should be dissolved.
- MCSA invited into meeting and Angela reiterated why they are here - purpose to discuss issue and provide context before further steps are taken.
- MCSA VP shared a presentation. Discussed their promotional materials and merchandise in connection with community engagement. Presented all the activities they hosted in 2025, which included events during their suspension. Discussed their core mission and goals.
- Angela told them their presentation missed the point of the meeting. Reiterated the severity of misconduct.
- MCSA Treasurer - says they're eager to learn and get financial training and follow official procedures. Says they will submit all required documents. They said they use Mandarin to maintain clarity with club members. In future will conduct all financial activity with full transparency. Operating outside MONSU financial system was a "mistake". They want financial training to master the official procedures.
- Angela flagged their executives already had their MONSU clubs training in March 2025 according to our provided documents from Amy. Angela said something in Chinese - reiterating information provided by Amy.
- Angela emphasised their financial behaviour has legal consequences.
- MCSA Treasurer says they believe in the mission of their society and want to remain affiliated - that's why they are in attendance today. As members of MONSU they successfully held many events/activities with high levels of student engagement. Eager to continue with MONSU, not just for ability to book rooms and use spaces, but because they value the official platform and endorsement provided by MONSU. They believe MONSU affiliation will help them attract more members and gain credibility in the eyes of students. They hope to grow and contribute.
- MCSA VP said they had an internal AGM and have decided on executive for 2026. This wasn't an official AGM. The new team is not in attendance but very excited for 2026. We do not know who these executive members are.
- MCSA President - money from sponsors and tickets through Humanitix forms. They contacted MONSU for some material supplies for events. Angela reiterated they have to use the account provided by MONSU. MCSA President said they've had a cash sponsor and this money went into a MONSU account this year - Rebecca says this is something she'll have to verify. MCSA President says they're "so apologetic... they

don't really check their email," says this semester they've already seen some change but still have some mistakes to correct.
