# **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

SUBJECT: Amendments to the MONSU Caulfield Incorporated Constitution

PREAMBLE: Previous MONSU Caulfield elections have been marred by a misuse of power. The Constitution has been used as a way of barring student involvement and minimising the power of the people it is built to represent. The 2021 Student Council refuses to let this continue any further. The amendments outlined below will guarantee that all enrolled, feepaying students at Monash Caulfield will have the support, service and representation they deserve. This set of changes will affirm the work we have done to be the most inclusive MONSU Caulfield Student Council that has ever been. These amendments are critical to guarantee that students who have previously had their democratic rights stripped, will not have this happen to them again. This set of changes is critical for the future of our organisation, and for the students at Monash Caulfield.

#### Current

#### C34. Eligibility to Stand and Vote

**34.1** All members who have been enrolled and completed one full semester may stand in elections except for the positions of President and Vice President. Members who have been enrolled and completed two full semesters may stand for the positions of President and Vice President.

34.2 Members who are enrolled in Semester 1 and Semester 2 in the year of office with the intention to complete a full year may stand

**34.3** All members may vote in elections **34.4** C34.1, C34.2, C34.3 do not prevent the constitution or regulations from limiting the eligibility to stand and vote in particular elections to specified categories of students.

#### **Proposed**

Replace with the following: **C34.** Eligibility to Stand and Vote All students may stand in MONSU Caulfield elections except for:

- a. students who are full-time staff of MONSU Caulfield or the University;
   and
- officers who have ceased to be enrolled students of the University

34.2 All students may vote in MONSU
Caulfield elections
34.3 C34.1 and C34.2 do not prevent
this constitution or the regulations from
limiting the eligibility to stand and vote in
particular elections to a specified group
or groups of students

This amendment will remove the exclusive rights of members to stand and vote in the MONSU Caulfield elections and instead allow all students to participate in the elections.

This change will ensure the elections are accessible to all Caulfield students, not just members, thus greatly expanding and preserving democracy on our campus.

### <u>Current</u>

C35. Eligibility to Hold Positions 35.1 A member may stand for, but not hold:

- a. more than one (1) officer position,
- b. more then (1) position on the same MONSU Caulfield body, or.
- Any MONSU Club executive position of President/chair, Vice President/Vice Chair, Treasurer or Secretary

## **Proposed**

Replace with the following C35. Eligibility to Hold Positions

35.1 A student may stand for but not hold

- a. more than one (1) officer position; or,
- b. more than one (1) position on the same MONSU Caulfield body

This amendment will provide MONSU Club Executives with the opportunity to hold a position on MONSU Student Council.
