1. Change of election regulations

Discussion:

James Stedman provides a brief background on the necessity of changing election regulations as recommended after the previous MONSU Election of 2024. Outlines key recommendations (Refer to Item 2 in Papers Provided for Information) and thoroughly explains the reasonings as to why the Returning Officer provided these recommendations.

Notes the issue of campaigning on campus, and when campaigning should begin. Activities Officer (1) suggests it would be ideal for campaigning to begin in the week before the voting period, in order to encourage engagement and visibility. Clarifies Student Council's specific restrictions regarding on-campus campaigning.

Raises the process of publicity being approved by the Returning Officer, which was a burdensome process. Suggestion that all campaign material must be sent to the Returning Officer, but approval is not needed to begin distribution. The Returning Officer will retain rights to remove and restrict campaign material.

Outlines outdated rules in current Election Regulations, and reasons for their removal.
