**Solve Student Issues initiative + Student Voice Panel**



Notes:	Mehika Agarwal raises that MONSU could be doing more to bring new initiatives and policies to the university, proposing that at each council meeting, council should discuss a current student issue and make a plan to address it. Key issues identified in a 2025 Caulfield-based survey revealed key issues with the carpark, AI policies, how to find accommodation, and student rights. Rebecca Murphy suggests building an issues register. Shreedevi Iyengar raises that council members should attend more events where they can personally hear student issues, such as anonymous group discussions. Anna Andrasi suggests an anonymous box for people to submit issues and tips. Council agreed that one-on-one conversations would be unproductive and discourage students from sharing their experiences.
