<p><b>1. Adjustment to Free Period Product Offering.</b></p> <p>Discussion: A proposal from the Women's Officer for the Executive Student Council to consider spending an additional \$2000 on 2 new portable period product dispensers and period packs, for the Women's and Queer lounges. Mary Swarnika Noyel Nerio explains costs</p>

as outlined in item 1, with a total of approximately \$2000 which includes refills throughout the year. This initiative is more cost effective than the current system of providing menstrual products, and more sustainable. The product dispensers could be brought to MONSU Pantry. There's no record of how many products have been used in the past, but an increase in demand is expected if they are offered at MONSU Pantry. These products are also required by transgender students, so the queer lounge should also have a dispenser.
