NOTICE OF ELECTION

The MONSU Caulfield Inc. (**MONSU**) 2026 Annual Elections will be held from Monday 14 September 2026 to Thursday 17 September 2026 for the following positions:

Eligibility

To be eligible to nominate for all positions except NUS Delegates in the MONSU Caulfield Annual Elections students must be a member of MONSU Caulfield. To nominate for the position of NUS Delegate students must be eligible to be a member of MONSU Caulfield.

To join as a member students must log into the MONSU Caulfield website (<https://www.monsu.org/login/>) using the student login. Membership is open to undergraduate students enrolled in a course at the Caulfield or City (Melbourne) campuses.

Students must be a member by the close of nominations (5pm Tuesday 1 September) in order to stand as a candidate in the election for any position except NUS Delegate.

All undergraduate students enrolled at either the Caulfield or City (Melbourne) campus are eligible to vote once they have joined MONSU Caulfield as a member.

Any candidates who submit eligibility requests to the returning officer must include the following statement in their email:

"I consent to Monash University providing the MONSU Returning Officer with personal information about me (my name, enrolment status, course location and course title) for the purpose of verifying certain attributes of my enrolment with Monash University to determine my eligibility to participate in the student council election."

Failure to include the above statement in requests for eligibility confirmation may mean you have not submitted appropriate material and your request may not be actionable per university requirements.

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Ticket Registration and Re-registration

You may re-register a ticket from 9:00am on Monday 17 August until 5:00pm on Monday 24 August. You can register a new ticket from 9:00am on Wednesday 19 August until 5pm Tuesday 25 August.

Nominations

Nominations for all positions will open at 9am Wednesday 26 August and close at 5pm on Tuesday 1 September.

Details on eligibility requirements for all positions can be found in the Election Regulations. You may nominate via a google form via the election webpage upon the opening of nominations. If you wish to submit your nomination in soft copy format, nomination forms will be available on the MONSU elections webpage (<https://www.monsu.org/business/elections/>) or by contacting the Returning Officer. Please note, if you nominate via the soft copy format, your nomination will take longer to process.

Candidates may submit a candidate statement and a photograph with their nomination. These must be received by the close of nominations. Statement and Photographs can be submitted by emailing the Returning Officer (monsu.returningofficer@gmail.com). You may submit a candidate statement of up to 200 words. Further details regarding candidate statements can be found in the Election Regulations. Candidates may withdraw at any time prior to the close of polling.

Voting

Polling will be conducted online between 9am Monday 14 September and 5pm Thursday 17 September.
