KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Photography Services

1. Under the direction of the Creative Manager, act as a photographer for MONSU Caulfield.
2. Shoot photography content for websites, creative projects and social media.
3. Collaborate with our Marketing and Communications, Event and Workshop teams.

Events Photography & Photobooth Services

1. Shoot photography content at all MONSU Caulfield events, including on-campus activations, signature event weeks and off-campus events.
2. Deliver and operate photobooth installations.
3. Collaborate with our Student Experience team.

Mentoring Program

1. Actively participate in the MONSU Caulfield Mentoring Program as a mentee.
2. Develop workplace experience with the added benefit of an experienced mentor.

Work Health & Safety

1. Ensure compliance with all Monash University and MONSU Caulfield WHS Policies, Procedures and instructions.
2. Take immediate action to rectify any unsafe situations or acts.
